### What is the purpose of the assessment?

- It allows to determine the right mix of capacity development interventions, eg:
  - Information dissemination
  - Education
  - Joint Research
  - Facilitation of strategic workshops
  - Others? Mentoring
- If done at a regional level, capacity development interventions can be spread judiciously across nations
